

SAFETY IS OUR #1 PRIORITY AS WE STRIVE TO MAKE A DIFFERENCE
DROP OFF AND PICK UP PROCEDURES FOR PARENTS AND STUDENTS ARRIVING IN
OUR CAR LOOP

Our school is a highly congested community with multiple schools located just a few blocks from each other. We have put procedures together to move the traffic as quickly as possible while maintaining STUDENT SAFETY as our primary objective. There are several signs to refer to as you drop your student off before school or pick them up after school. Two signs state: PLEASE PULL ALL THE WAY FORWARD, one sign states PARENT DROP-OFF, and three signs state STUDENT PICK UP DROP OFF. We have five teachers and an Assistant Principal daily out front to help with the pick up and drop off procedures. If you need assistance, please see one of the teachers on supervision duty.

1. Pull as far as you can forward before attempting to let your student exit your car.
2. There is a speed bump painted yellow right in front of the Administration building. This is the first place a student should exit or enter a car.
3. When you pick up your student, move to the outside lane so that you can exit the school without waiting for other students to load or unload their car.
4. Do not pick up your student or drop your student off in the parking lot, unless you park your car and escort your student across the road.
5. Do not pick your student up or drop your student off outside the chain link fence on the side of the road. Traffic moves extremely fast during school hours and this practice is a detriment to student safety.
